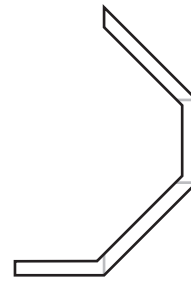


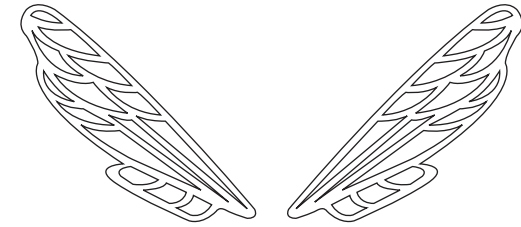
ACCESSORY TEMPLATE:

Print this sheet on plain white paper, and place it beneath a sheet of clear thick plastic. Use a Sharpie to trace the lines. Cut the shapes out with a hobby knife or scissors, and fold at the lines. Some items have additional instructions beneath them.

Please do not sell these, redistribute these, or claim these are your own work. These designs were created by Luke Porter in January 2009.

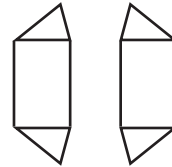


CHEST STRAP

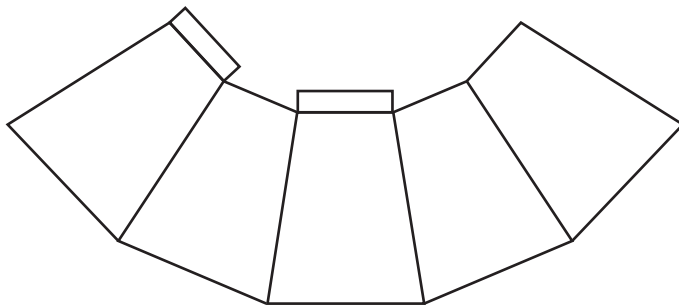
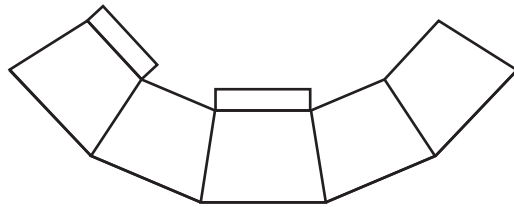


WINGS

The interior lines are just a suggestion for how you might paint these. You could also print another sheet of these on decal paper and use that on top the plastic.

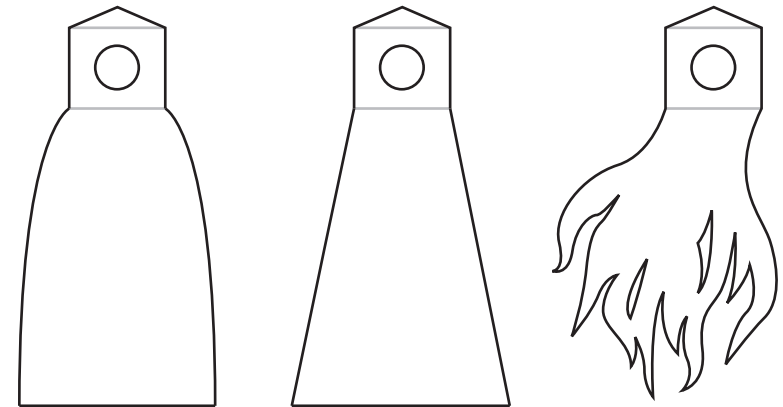


SHOULDER PADS



SKIRT AND DRESS

One back piece will fold over the other. Use superglue in between these pieces. The two tabs on top will fold down and hug the chest peg on the hip piece. You can glue these in place for a more stable fit.



CAPES

You can use a standard hole puncher for the top piece. I recommend gluing these in place after painting. The "V" in the front of the cape is optional, and can be left off.
